ThinkPad SelectaDock III User's Guide Supplement

If you are using the SelectaDock III docking station in Windows 98 environment, resuming normal operation from hibernation mode or suspend mode might take a long time. This is not a problem with the docking station.

If you have not attached a SCSI device to the docking station but have enabled the SCSI function, the docking station queries the SCSI device until the timeout timer is reached. You need to connect a SCSI device according to the instructions in the *User's Guide* or you need to disable the SCSI port as follows:

- 1 Start the ThinkPad Configuration program.
- 2 Click on Docking Station.
- 3 Click on Device Manager....
- 4 Click on SCSI controllers.

The SCSI devices are listed.

- **5** Click on the SCSI device name that is in the docking station.
- 6 Click on the Properties button.
- 7 Put a check mark in the **Disable in this hardware profile** check box by clicking on it.
- 8 Click on OK.
